Recall of Judge Loren McMaster

s many of you are aware, a small group of critics has launched an effort to recall Superior Court Judge Loren McMaster because of a recent decision he made.

On Tuesday, December 14th Loren was formally served with a Notice Of Intent for Recall that allows recall proponents to move forward with their petition.

Friends of Judge McMaster and a number of concerned citizens in Sacramento County have formed a political organization to defeat this recall effort and to defend Loren. The organization's contact information is:










A President's Fond Farewell
